Rapid Access to Treatment

Immediate admission is available to Renascent's fee for service Complete Care Program for alcohol and drug addiction, which includes our 28- to 42-day comprehensive inpatient treatment program, Continuing Care, Family Care, and Alumni Programs.

Detox Facilitation

For your patient's safety, we require 72 hours to eight days of abstinence, depending on the substance. Renascent will coordinate withdrawal management services for your patient prior to admission as necessary.

Admission and Communication

We will facilitate intake, assessment, and medical screening. With your patient's consent, you will be part of the Primary Care Team, and receive regular progress updates and a confidential discharge summary upon program completion.

Interdisciplinary Clinical Team

Our multidisciplinary team of clinical professionals includes registered psychotherapists, a clinical psychologist, an M.D. certified with the Board of Addiction Medicine, a registered dietitian, and certified addiction counsellors with lived experience of alcohol, drug, and food addiction and long-term recovery.

Accessible Care

Through the Renascent Foundation and its generous donors, we offer affordably priced treatment programs and never turn anyone away due to financial circumstances.

Clinical Consultation

On a non-crisis basis, Renascent is available to consult with healthcare professionals who have questions about accessing care in the system and resolving complex medical and concurrent mental health issues.

Renascent's clinical staff draw on their own lived experience of addiction and long-term recovery to help clients see the potential for their own recovery.
